Engaged couples, one of whom must be an active, registered member of the parish, must contact the Parish Office at least six months in advance of the intended wedding.

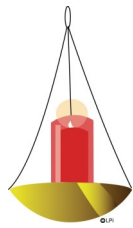

**The Sanctuary Lamp** in the Adoration Chapel is in Memory of the **Meffe and DiLorenzo Families** by **John Meffe**.

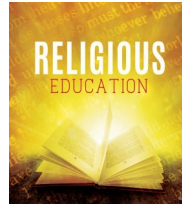
**The Sunday Evening Regional Mass** for the Greensburg area has changed. **Please note these two important changes to the place and time:**

### HOMILY

### CREED (RECITED)

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.
