Adoration Schedule for St. Bruno & St. Paul Parishes

Simple Rule: Where the Mass is for the day, is where Adoration is for the day!

Mondays: @ St. Paul Church

- Adoration: After 8am Mass until 3:15pm
- 3:00pm Divine Mercy Chaplet & Benediction

Tuesdays: @ St. Bruno Church

- Adoration: After 8am Mass until Confessions end
- Confessions: 3:00pm – 3:30pm (or until finished)

Wednesdays: @ St. Paul Church

- Adoration: After 8am Mass until 3:15pm
- 3:00pm Divine Mercy Chaplet & Benediction

Thursdays: @ St. Bruno Church

- Adoration: After 9am Morning Prayer until 6:45pm
- Confessions: 6:00pm
- Benediction: 6:45pm, followed by 7:00pm Mass

Fridays: @ St. Paul Church

- Adoration: After 8am Mass until 3:15pm
- 3:00pm Divine Mercy Chaplet & Benediction

For Adoration at Saint Bruno Church (Tuesdays and Thursdays):

Throughout the day, please enter St. Bruno Church by the side door closest to the elevator and next to the Rectory.

Handicap Parking Spaces in the driveway between the Church and the Rectory are available for those in need.

Solemn Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament will take place on the Main Altar of St. Bruno Church. Some chairs and kneelers will be set up in the Sanctuary for Adoration or adorers are welcome to use any of the pews in the nave of the church.

To exit the church after Adoration, you can use any exterior door.

For Adoration at Saint Paul Church (Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays):

Throughout the day, please enter St. Paul Church by either door adjacent to the roundabout (either the handicap entrance next to the Office or the side door at the other end of the portico/overhang).

You may exit by any exterior door.

This change to Adoration is in order to implement Diocesan practices of keeping the Private Residence of Priests separate from public spaces of worship, but also to seek greater participation in Adoration. I earnestly believe that Adoration available throughout the week at both St. Bruno Church and St. Paul Church will allow for greater communal involvement and opportunity to adore our Blessed Lord in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar.

Additionally, I would be remiss not to thank the many faithful adorers who have dedicated part of their lives to be present to our Lord in Adoration over many years. I pray that their dedication to adoring our Lord will remain steadfast and inspire others to begin visiting our Lord in Adoration.

As St. Pope John XXIII said, “There is no doubt that a flood of graces will descend upon your family and the world if more souls would become docile pupils of Adoration.”
