Context & Contemplation

Hospitality is one of the great virtues of the Old Testament, revealing hearts that are open not only to strangers but also to God. In the story of Elijah and the widow of Zarephath (1 Kings 17), a poor widow welcomes the prophet despite having only a handful of flour and a little oil. Her generosity becomes the occasion for God's blessing, as her jar of flour and jug of oil do not run dry.

A similar spirit is found in the account of Elisha and the Shunammite woman (2 Kings 4). Unlike the widow, she is a woman of means, yet she recognizes God's presence in the prophet and prepares a room for him whenever he passes by. Her hospitality is not merely an act of kindness but an expression of faith. In return, God blesses her with the gift of a son.

Together, these stories remind us that hospitality is not measured by how much we possess but by how willingly we share what we have. Whether rich or poor, those who make room for God's servants ultimately make room for God Himself and discover that His blessings far exceed what they give away.

St. Paul Parish will celebrate its Parish Feast Day, the Solemnity of Ss. Peter and Paul on Monday, June 29th. Instead of a small Parish Mass in the morning, there will be a solemn Mass at 6:30 PM followed by a Eucharistic Procession. After Mass and the procession there will be a cookout at the Pavilion.

Also, leading up to the Parish Feast Day Mass, there will be 33 hours of continuous Adoration (1 hour for each year of Jesus' earthly life). Adoration will begin after the 9:00 AM Sunday Mass on June 28th and continue until the Feast Day Mass on June 29th at 6:30 PM.
