Context & Contemplation

Jesus' parables are not simply pleasant stories with helpful morals. They are windows into the Kingdom of God. When Jesus speaks about seed, soil, yeast, sheep, coins, vineyards, weddings, and banquets, He is showing us that God's Kingdom is often hidden in the ordinary things of life.

Parables had a long history in ancient literature. The Old Testament prophets used images and stories to reveal divine truth. Nathan's parable of the poor man's lamb led King David to recognize his own sin. Jewish teachers also used short comparisons and stories to explain the Law and the ways of God. Even Greek and Roman writers used fables and symbolic stories to teach wisdom. But Jesus' parables are different. They do not merely teach us how to behave; they invite us to enter the reign of God.

A parable both reveals and challenges. To the humble heart, it opens a mystery. To the hardened heart, it may remain only a story. That is why Jesus often says, "Whoever has ears ought to hear." The question is not only whether we understand the parable, but whether we are willing to let it change us.

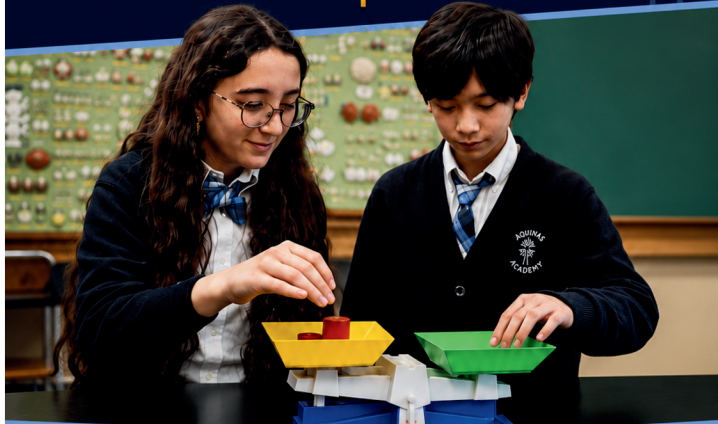
